Entry Method	Complete the official entry form at grainproducers.com.au/win-a-holiday/ with all requested details including full name, contact phone number, email address, suburb/locality and postcode, details of the main grain crop types being produced in 2023, and an answer to the following question in no more than 25 words: <i>“Tell us in 25 words or less about your ideal holiday and destination away from the farm”.</i> Submit the completed entry form.
Maximum Entries	Limit one (1) entry per entrant during the Promotional Period.
Winner Determination	Game of skill. Chance plays no part in determining the Winner. Judging will take place by the Promoter on 5 February 2024 from 9:30am AEDT. The Promoter will select six (6) Entrants who have most creatively answered the promotional question (“Finalists”). Determinations of the judges will be final.
